\*(HRA) requires (Initial Assessment/Annual Reassessment) Following Part C Reporting Guidelines. \*Quarterly Case Management Check In - This will only apply for members who are enrolled longer than 91 days. The reimbursement will be done at the beginning of the next quarter. If a member disenrolls at the end of the year, member is not eligible for the last quarter incentive.
